“MIRACLE IN YOUR MOUTH”

Christians have spiritual power through their mouths as given by God. Our mouths can save us (Rom. 10:10-11), but it can also bring death. Christians can change their lives through the declaration of the word of God; for every trial, we overcome (1 Jn. 4:4); for every accusation, we refute (Is. 54:17); in poverty, we can prosper (Phil. 4:19); and in failure, we can succeed (Gen. 39:3). Thus, Christians can declare miracles in their life and others through their mouth(s).

What are the miracles in our mouth?

1. **Healing Words.** Our mouths can utter healing. We must have the healing words of God in our life and in our hearts (Prov. 4:20-22). We should openly declare the name God who is the healer (Ex. 15:26; 1 Pet. 2:24) and His promise of healing (Jer. 30:17).
2. **Words of Faith.** The words are very near for us to obey (Deut. 30:14). We sometimes blame others for our state, but what we declare in our mouth can affect us. Also, we often get caught in the negative state we are in through our mouth (Prov. 6:2).
3. **God's word.** We can boldly confess the greatness of God and His word. It is a choice to bring life to the world and to ourselves. We must choose what we speak, for it can bring aggravation or healing (Prov. 12:18), life or death (Prov. 18:21). Christians must choose God's words that bring life.
4. **Speak only God's goodness.** God does not want us to speak negatively about our life, rather we should speak on the goodness of God. We have to stop speaking words of defeat, and speak words of victory. Here are some good things God gave to us:

1.4.1. **While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.**

1.4.2. **He sent His only son to save us.**

1.4.3. **His plans for us are for our good.**

1.4.4. **He is with us in our problems or persecutions.**

1.4.5. **He changed our life.**

1.4.6. **He healed us.**

5. **Songs of Deliverance.** We can speak about God who is our refuge and protector (Ps. 32:7) in all aspects in our life; therefore, we must confess Him to the world (Rom. 10:10; Is. 55:11).
6. **The power of blessing.** We have the power to bless (Jas. 3:10). We utter blessing to our family rather than hear our curses.
7. **Speak of blessing today.** The words of blessings are precious to those who hear it (Prov. 25:11), but it must be spoken out.
8. **Get on the offense.** Our mouth can declare the might of God (Eph. 6:10). We start our day by speaking the power of His word and be aggressive in eliminating all negativity in life.

Conclusion

Our mouth has the power to bring forth life to our family and to the world. It is the grace we can use to share the power of God. We must win our battle in life and continue to use pleasant (healing) speech to our family and to everyone.
